# Biology / Biochemistry Convocation Ceremony Instructions for Candidates

1. The Biology / Biochemistry Convocation Ceremony will be held on Friday May 18, 2018 at 8:30 AM in the Arena. Please arrive at the Pritchard Gym to check in by 7:30 am. You will check in at the table assigned to your group and be given the yellow attendance card you filled out prior. If you did not fill one out, you will be given one when you check in. You will then be directed to your assigned group area. Your guests should go directly to the Arena. Faculty and Graduates will begin to line up for the Procession to the Arena promptly at 8:15. **Time is critical. It is essential to be on time.**

You will hold on to the yellow card until you begin to line up. At that time Biology staff and faculty marshals will help the Graduates line up alphabetically and then collect the completed information cards. It is essential to maintain your place in line once the cards have been collected as this is the order in which you will be called up to the platform and individually recognized during the Ceremony. The cards will also be given in this same order to the professional photographer who will document your recognition during the Ceremony, so please make sure that you stay in line according to alphabetical order.

**3. The Procession:** (All left/right directions refer to sides as you face the stage)

The Procession will involve two columns with the Biology Majors / Minors / Groups 1 and 2 on the left, preceded by the Biology Banner Bearers) and Masters Graduates, Biochemistry Majors and Biology Majors and Minors in Group 3 on the right (preceded by the Biochemistry Banner Bearers). Tassels should be worn on the right side of your cap! The procession will start in the Pritchard Gym and proceed to the Arena. Once in the Arena, follow your faculty marshal down the center aisle to the front row and move to your seat in an orderly fashion; Biology graduates to the left side and Biochemistry to the right. The Marshals will count the number of students to enter each row, please go all the way to the end of the row so that it is filled with no vacant seats AND REMAIN STANDING!

Degree candidates will be presented collectively by Major and then recognized individually. When it is time for your group to be recognized follow the directions of the faculty Marshal who will have graduates stand up by row and proceed to the platform. When their names are read, **Graduates will enter the platform on the right-hand side**, proceed across the stage to receive their certificate(s) and exit via the opposite stairwell on the left-hand side of the platform, return to their seats and be seated.

#### Conclusion and exit:

Following brief concluding farewell remarks, the faculty and students will participate in a Recessional march with music again from the bagpipers. The Biology and Biochemistry banner bearers will lead an exit from the Arena through the opening immediately to the right of the platform. The platform party will follow the banner bearers and the marshals will lead their groups, beginning with the front row, from both left and right side (i.e. two columns).

#### Please keep the procession intact to the Gymnasium.

Just a reminder to all our graduates: Although tickets are needed for the University Ceremony, NO tickets are needed for the Biology and Biochemistry Convocation Ceremony. You may invite as many family members and friends as you would like. As you can see from the instructions above, all of our graduates are individually recognized during this Ceremony and there will be a Professional Photographer to take each Students picture.
